“Being a monarchist is a useless, if not entirely dangerous idea, unless you realise that the source of the power of the Monarch is the same as the power of the People that originally created the government, and delegated specific powers to the government, but not all powers which are, and should remain, with the People. “There is such a thing as an accredited course, and these aren’t offered only at colleges or universities, by the way. There is such a thing as an accredited degree program, such as an accredited Associate’s, Foundation, Bachelor’s, or Master’s degree. There is such a thing as a degree, diploma, certificate, or course accredited by a professional organisation (professional accreditation). There is such a thing as an accredited Professional Doctoral program. There are also accredited colleges, universities, or educational institutions, although not all of their programs may have canonical academic or professional accreditation. However, despite what lots of people may think, there is no such thing as an accredited Doctor of Philosophy, an accredited PhD, or an accredited Research Doctorate. In fact, if you hear or read a phrase like ‘we offer accredited PhDs’ in any advertisement, be very suspicious. Not only there is no such thing as an accredited PhD, but any real PhD can never be accredited by its very nature, because you can only accredit canonical, orthodox, received, sanctioned, or time-honoured knowledge, not new knowledge that was discovered or developed recently by a PhD student or team of students. My PhD in Cyberanthropology from Cosmopolitan University & Research Institute is an unaccredited PhD, like any real PhD, and it is an honorary PhD, just like any real PhD as well, whether the diploma has the words ‘honorary’ or ‘honoris causa’ printed on it, or not. Originally the PhD was granted by universities to learned individuals who had achieved the approval of their peers, and who had demonstrated a long and productive career in the field of philosophy, and it was usually awarded when the scholar was 40 years old, or older. I earned my PhD the ‘old-fashioned way’: through the approval of my peers, and my PhD was awarded for research and interdisciplinary work in the field of the study of humanity (the ‘-anthropology’ suffix in the word *cyberanthropology*), as applied to virtual communities and networked environments (the ‘cyber-’ prefix in the word *cyberanthropology*). I was also 43 years old when I received my PhD, so I was just the right age too!”
